This is a volunteer (un-paid) position. Painters are welcome to take digital images of samples they painted for use in a portfolio with reference to Bisque It. Painters who choose to return and/or do their own pieces to keep may be offered discounts at owners' discretion.

Volunteer expectations & responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

- Contribute to a positive team environment and openly, pro-actively discuss any design ideas or opportunities for improvement with the studio owners.
- Demonstrate enthusiasm, studio/pottery knowledge (or the willingness to learn it), integrity, and honesty that promote the culture and values of Bisque it while working in the studio.
- Set a positive example and develop positive relationships at all times with Bisque it staff & customers.
- Participates in scheduled painting shifts with reliable and consistent attendance and punctuality.

Required Skills & Abilities:

- Art training, education and/or experience with pottery painting or similar/related skills such as painting on other mediums, drawing and/or crafts of a similar nature.
- Effective oral communication skills
- Strong interpersonal skills
- Strong problem-solving skills
- Ability to work as part of a team & demonstrate Team-building skills
- Ability to work in a 'think-outside-the-box' changing environment
